## <u>Government funding support available (April 2024) – 38 weeks a year (term time)</u> (please check <u>www.childcarechoices.gov</u> for eligibility and to apply for your code)

At Early Birds, families will be able to access their childcare support entitlement from the term after their second birthday.

### Childcare support for 2-year-olds - working families

Families of 2-year-olds who are working may be entitled to **15 hours per week** across 38 weeks.

### Childcare support for 2-year-olds - supported families

Families of 2-year-olds who receive additional government support may be entitled to **15 hours per week** across 38 weeks. If the snack fund additional charge is a barrier to your child receiving their entitlement please speak to us, we may be able to help.

## Universal funding for 3–4-year-olds

All families of 3–4-year-olds are entitled to **15 hours per week** of childcare support across 38 weeks. If the snack fund additional charge is a barrier to your child receiving their entitlement please speak to us, we may be able to help.

#### Childcare support for 3–4-year-olds – working families

Working families with a 3–4-year-old may be entitled to an additional 15 hours childcare support per week (**30 hours per week in total**) across 38 weeks.

#### Once you have your code you can use your entitlement as follows (subject to availability): -

#### **Care Charge Note**

The funding we receive from the government only allows us to cover the cost of staffing within government guidelines and building costs. To ensure sustainability of our pre-school the care charge will be added to your invoice and contributes towards snacks, cooking ingredients, daily play-doh ingredients, wipes, tissues, toilet rolls, hand wash, sun cream, cleaning products and other consumables.

Please supply own nappies. If you would like a particular brand of wipes, please supply these alongside nappies.

### <u>Government funding support available (September 2024) – 38 weeks a year (term time)</u> (please check <u>www.childcarechoices.gov</u> for eligibility and to apply for your code)

At Early Birds, families will be able to access their childcare support entitlement from the term after their child's first birthday.

#### Childcare support for 1 – 2-year-olds – working families

Families of children aged over one who are working may be entitled to **15 hours per week** across 38 weeks.

## Childcare support for 2-year-olds - supported families

Families of 2-year-olds who receive additional government support may be entitled to **15 hours per week** across 38 weeks. If the care charge or deposit is a barrier to your child receiving their entitlement please speak to us, we may be able to help.

#### Universal funding for 3–4-year-olds

All families of 3–4-year-olds are entitled to **15 hours per week** of childcare support across 38 weeks. If the care charge or deposit is a barrier to your child receiving their entitlement please speak to us, we may be able to help

## Childcare support for 3–4-year-olds – working families

Working families with a 3–4-year-old may be entitled to an additional 15 hours childcare support per week (**30 hours per week in total**) across 38 weeks.

#### Once you have your code you can use your entitlement as follows (subject to availability): -

15 hours per week entitlement	30 hours entitlement
(38 weeks of year – term time)	(38 weeks of year – term time)
5 x morning or afternoon sessions	5 x sessions (8.30 – 2.30)
4 x morning or afternoon sessions with lunch	4 x full days (8 – 3.30)
2 x full days (8.00 – 3.30)	

You can start your entitlement from the term following your child's 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday (on receiving a signed acceptance of place form).

**Holiday clubs -** Subject to interest and minimum numbers we will also be offering a holiday club for one week during the Easter holidays and two weeks in the summer holidays. If this is popular, and subject to demand, this could be increased.

**Refundable Deposit** – Once offered a place we require a refundable deposit of £25 to secure your space. This will be refunded to you on completion of one month at Early Bird. This is non-refundable if you decide not to take up your place.

**Notice Period** – we require a minimum of 6 weeks' notice to terminate your contract with Early Bird.

**Invoices** – will be sent to you two weeks prior to the start of each half term date. Payment will be due on the first date of each half term.

**Future Plans** – as the government funding support is expanded in September 2025, we would consider opening a teatime slot from 3.30 to 5.00pm subject to parent demand.
