What is EYPP?

Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) is additional funding we receive to support the outcomes of children who meet the criteria. You will be informed by your child's key person if your child is entitled to EYPP.

What we do with the EYPP funding

The additional money is used to support the needs of each child and we are accountable for how the money is spent. At The Early Bird Pre-School this money is used to:

- Train staff in identified specific areas
- Contribute towards funding enrichment activities linked to the development of the child
- Contribute to purchasing additional resources linked to the development of the child
- Contribute to funding for additional support staff to deliver extra support e.g. small group activities, nurture groups

Parent Partnership

Your child's key person or the setting manager will speak to you about your child's development and how we are planning to use the EYPP funding to support your child's individual needs. You will be kept updated with your child's progress with regular catch up meetings with your key person.
